

Groovy Greeks

English

We will develop our story writing, write our own Greek myths, and diary entries about the Battle of Troy. We will write a playscript based on our knowledge of the Gods of Olympus and write a persuasive text about visiting Ancient Greece on holiday.

Geography and History

We will look at the position of the equator, Northern and Southern hemispheres, tropics of Cancer and Capricorn, Arctic and Antarctic. We will also locate and name seas and mountains.

We will investigate the Ancient Greeks and compare their civilisation. We will look at features of Ancient Greece and what they were famous for; we will identify artefacts and changes over time.

Science

We will be developing our knowledge of animals including humans by looking at different types of skeletons and muscles.

We will also learn about light, light and dark and look what causes shadows and reflections.

Art and D&T

We will be drawing like an artist, looking at texture, shading and abstract drawings.

In D&T we are evaluating and making biscuits and also creating a textile.

Computing

We will look at connecting computers, using inputs and outputs, and developing our knowledge of using programmes to publish.

PSHE

We will be exploring 'being me' and 'celebrating differences' through discussions and role play.

RE

We will look at the Trinity and what is important to Christians, whilst also learning about Hindu beliefs.
